

Information to Parents of Children attending a Preschool in Norrköping

Welcome to the 2021 Spring Term

A warm welcome to all of our preschool students and their parents for the new term. This information discusses procedures in our preschools in response to the coronavirus pandemic and COVID-19 illness. The information is aimed at those who have children in one of our preschools.

Our basic starting point is that our preschools in Norrköping will be open with regular activities on-site. The focus of the preschool is on learning and education where each and every child will experience development while feeling safe and secure. Head teachers and other staff will do everything within their power to establish the best possible preconditions for this.

Along with this we will be following the recommendations and advice of the Swedish Government, the Swedish Public Health Agency, and the Östergötland Region. All municipality activities in Norrköping will keep current on the prevailing situation.

Adjustments we need to make due to the pandemic

During the autumn, several adjustments were made to the preschool's activities and these adjustments will continue to be in effect during the spring term as well. This may mean for example that no large gatherings are held, meetings with parent and development discussions will take place online in digital format, extra cleaning in the preschools will be done, and pick-up and drop-off of students will take place outdoors. If the preschool temporarily closes

In the event of a high level of absence due to illness from COVID-19 and a possible strained situation as a consequence, the preschool may be closed during a temporary period. If this becomes necessary, you will receive information about from the preschool about what is planned. If the preschool closes, those parents who work in socially important activities will be entitled to after-school care for their children in another unit if both parents/legal guardians work in socially
